This last week I had the opportunity to share breakfast with the four other Rectors of Anglican Churches in the Highlands. We were joined by Bishop Peter Hayward and the topic of conversation was the "Jesus is _____" mission week and events. It was such a great encouragement to hear from the Bishop of evangelistic faithfulness and fruit in other parts of this southern area of the Diocese. The common thread from all was that, although the events were often well attended and helpful, the great encouragement was the small steps that so many individuals took in initiating conversation with their friends about Jesus. We do not underestimate the courage that it takes sometimes to speak up.

We have been hearing at church this month from the book of Jonah – a prophet not conspicuous for his courage! However, throughout the book we learn one key thing that ought to give us courage – Jonah's God is our God. He is the God whose word is powerful to achieve his purposes. He is the God whose grace is surprising and transforming. He is the God who is working out his wonderful plan of salvation in us and through us. What a great spur to courageous speaking this ought to be.
