



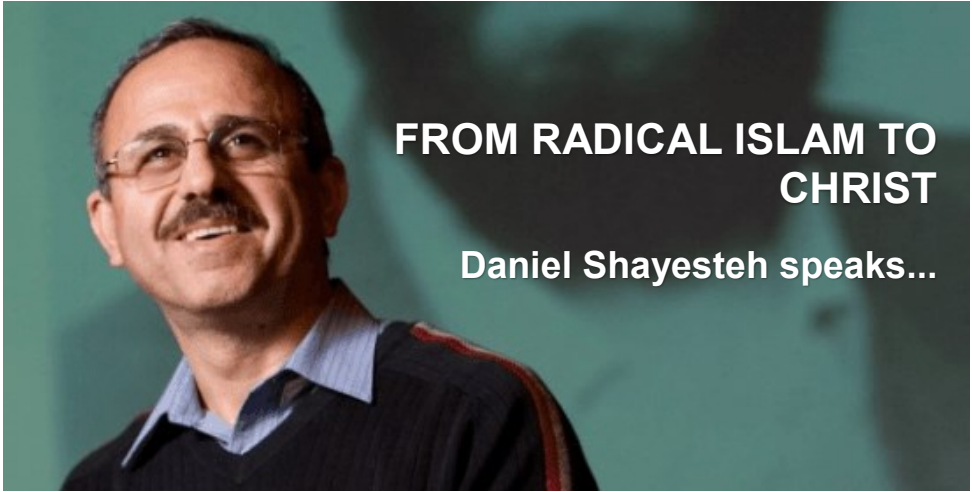

### **Is your Safe Ministry Training up to Date?**

Safe Ministry is a journey that starts when you first get involved in ministry to vulnerable people – children, teenagers and adults – and continues for the duration of that ministry.

And so, it is essential that all people involved in Anglican ministry to the vulnerable, including children and teenagers, are thoroughly equipped and trained for that journey with approved Safe Ministry training.

If you are in any way involved in ministry with young people, youth or vulnerable people, it is a diocesan requirement that you have done your **Working With Children Check** AND completed the **Safe Ministry Course** within the last 3 years.

The new course is online and takes approx. 4.5 hours for the full course, 3 hours for the refresher. Please contact the office if you would like to find out more about doing the course or go to <https://safeministry.training> to complete the course.
