Anglicare

As Anglicare Moss Vale is closing, they are changing from delivering services from a single location. The organisation will work closely with local volunteers and partners to deliver Food and Financial Assistance to the wider Highland Community from various different locations.

## At St Jude's

Food Storage in the Heritage hall—We will be storing various pantry items for Anglicare clients' needs. Volunteers will be needed to manage this, and put together food parcels upon request from Anglicare (this is not a drop in service, this is a pre arranged pick up of food/groceries). Anglicare clients will then pick up food packages, upon request.

Anglicare Counselling—We will provide a room for an Anglicare counsellor to conduct one on one counselling services for a day each fortnight.

## Other Churches

Mobile Community Pantry – Moss Vale & Mittagong

This will be a mobile food service, approximately twice a month in each town. No appointment needed for those in need to pick up groceries at a greatly reduced cost. There will be a social worker / Anglicare counsellor attending to assist with other needs (financial, housing etc).

We hope that these areas of assistance to the community of the Southern Highlands will be a blessing and help provide targeted and easier access to Anglicare services.
