Missions at St Judes

Sunday 30 June, a group of congregation members from St Jude's attended the 10 year anniversary of the Shoalhaven Aboriginal Community Church (ShACC).

Aboriginal pastor, Rev Canon Tom Slockee from Bateman's Bay, delivered the sermon. He mentioned how dreamtime stories and connectedness to creation, naturally lend themselves to spiritual ways of thinking.



There's a general understanding among most Indigenous nations that there's a creator God. This understanding finds its answer in Jesus Christ. We are all united and one people in Him. Tom also explained that it's not an easy thing for an Indigenous person (rural or urban), to step into a white man's church/ building/ traditions.

ShACC is an enduring but small congregation. The children's ministry is still in its infancy. In the long term they are hoping to be able to return to permanent accommodation within the redeveloped rectory. However in the intervening period, the shared Youth Centre accommodation has been quite unsettling. The most important need for the future, is an ordained Aboriginal minister.
