How to Vote

Log onto (or create) a MyServiceNSW account and vote (you still need your Medicare card).

Vote for RESTORATION OF SOUTH WALL as number 1.

- You can only vote in Wollondilly electorate
- You will find a lot of projects on the site, not all are church ones. Look for ours and put it number 1
- **VOTING CLOSES on AUGUST 15, so get going!**
