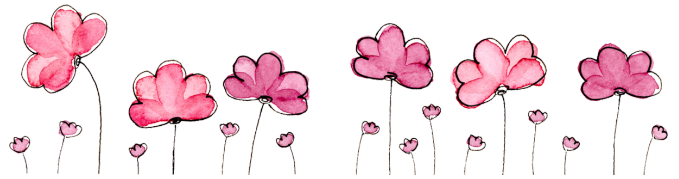

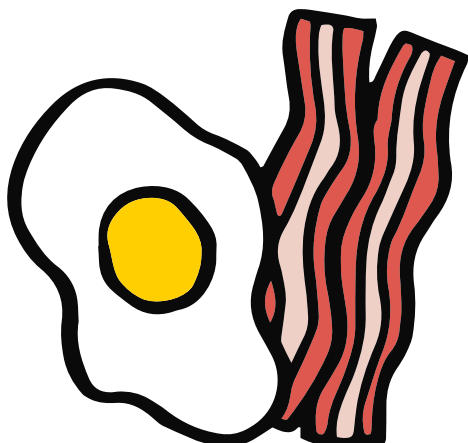
Retired Men's Group will meet on Friday 04 November at 10am for a light morning tea and 10.30 to hear Ian Hadfield from CMS. All men are most welcome

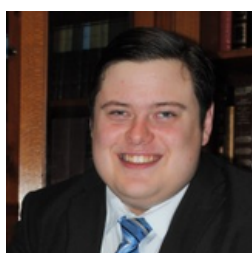
Save the date Saturday 12 November.
