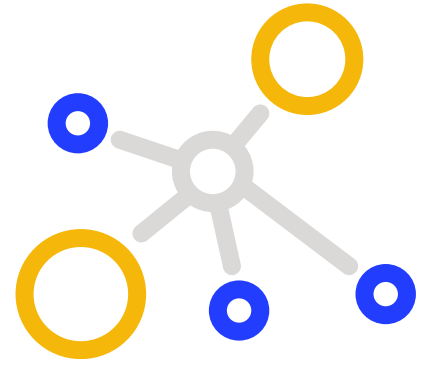

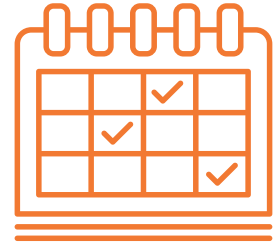
## SOUTHERN CROSS

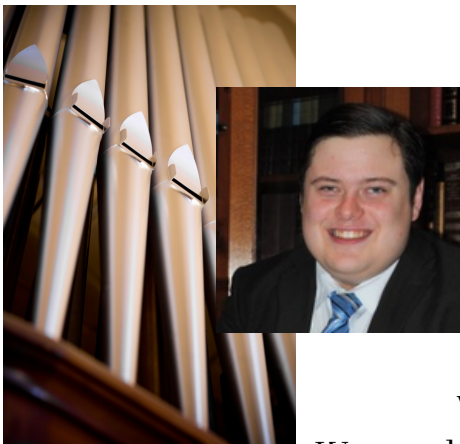
