Offertories for March 2022 were \$57,143 compared to \$60,249 and a budget of \$65,000. This is a disappointing drop of 5% on last year. Year to date to 31st March 2022 our offertories were \$182,487 compared to \$158,947 last year and a budget of \$194,000. While this is a good increase on last year our offertories will need to increase more to meet our budget.
