## YR12 & HSC STUDENTS

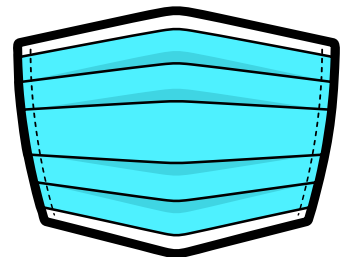

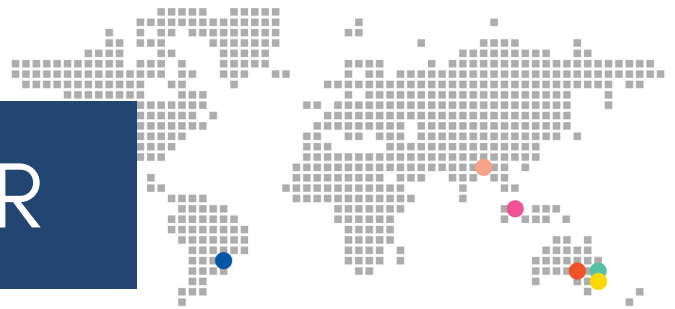
