Offertories for the month of June were \$64,818 compared to \$69,850 last year. This is a drop of 7%. For this current year to date to 31st May offertories were \$314,155 compared to \$293,329, an increase of 6.6%. Our budget for the year to 31st May was \$334,000 and we are 6% below the amount we need to meet our expenses.

Confirmation is the opportunity for Christians who were baptised when they were younger\* to confirm the promises their parents made on their behalf.

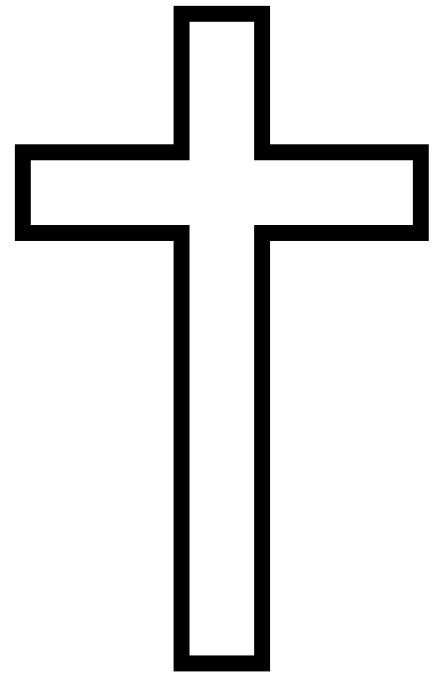

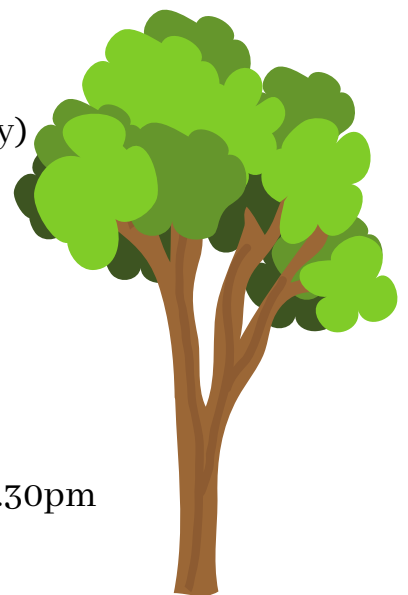
Earlier on the same day we will also be hosting the confirmation for Frensham students in the Traditional Church Building.

# LINK MISSIONARY NEWS

After much consideration and assessment, the missionary committee and the parish council earlier this year committed to supporting Siddique Paul in his ministry amongst Muslim people in south-west Sydney. We were greatly encouraged by his visit and had been looking forward to this partnership in the years ahead. However, we have recently received the news that Siddique has taken up a new full-time role with Baptist Mission Australia and so no longer needs support from individual churches. Accordingly, Siddique will no longer be a link missionary of St Jude's, although many of us will continue to pray for the work in which he is involved and for the needs of the community he is seeking to reach.

The parish council has agreed with the missionary committee's recommendation that the money that the parish had set aside for Siddique will now be designated as additional financial support for Shoalhaven Aboriginal Community Church to assist the newly appointed indigenous pastor.

We will investigate further opportunities for supporting work in south-west Sydney amongst Muslim communities from 2023.

## FROM THE RECTOR

Over the coming weeks I will be taking long service leave (Monday 13 June until mid August). During this period of time I am very glad that Graham will be leading the ministry team, and he has my complete confidence.

I am also glad that we have recently been able to increase the hours that Sarah Bull is available to serve on that team. As was announced two weeks ago Sarah is going from half a day to a full day per week, and is adding to her current responsibilities a particular focus on caring for and supporting the 8am and 9:30am traditional service ministry. She will be present each week at those two services and will be a key touch point for identifying needs and opportunities in those congregations. I personally am grateful for the role she will be able to play in my absence, and also for the way she will be able to assist me in my leadership and care for those two congregations moving forward.
