Confirmation is the opportunity for Christians who were baptised when they were younger* to confirm the promises their parents made on their behalf.

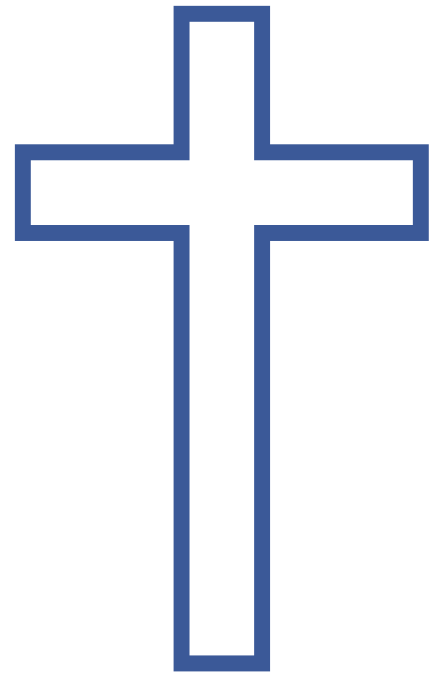

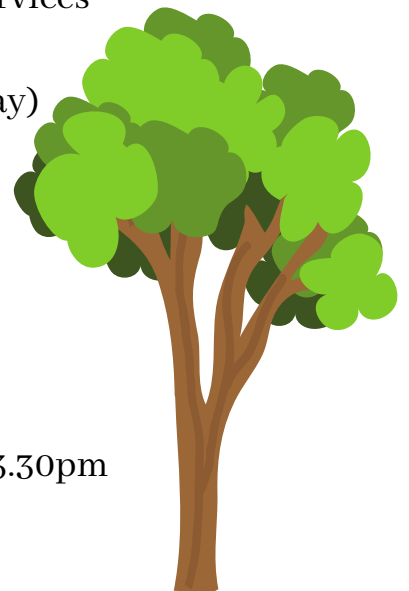

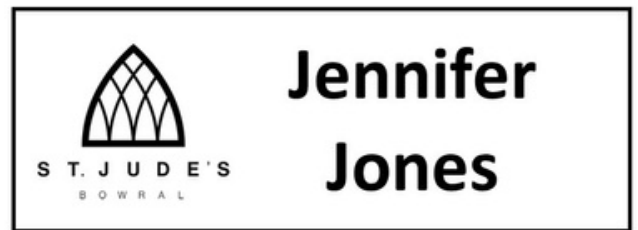


Jack and Lill Harradine,

NAME BADGES



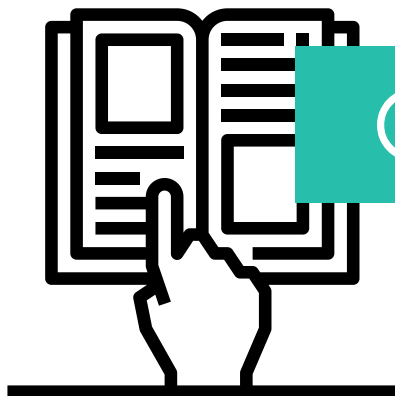
Name badges are being made for all St Jude's congregation members that would like them.

To buy a name tag, please use the signup sheets at the back of church buildings. Please provide your full name and phone number (mobile is preferred). Badges will be ordered through the church office, and then picked up and paid for by you at Southern Highlands Trophy Centre (near the train station, on Kirkham Rd).

When you sign the order sheet you are agreeing to pay for your badge at Southern Highlands Trophy Centre, 75 Kirkham Rd, Bowral NSW 2576.

The cost is \$15 each badge.

Once the badge is ready, you will receive a text/call from the shop and you may go and pay for it and pick it up.

There are many ways to give at St Jude's: Credit card, paypal, cash and by direct debit.

The "tap" and go device for those that would like to give their offertory with a debit/credit card, similar to a square reader that you would have seen in shops. It gives you the option to tap and give your offertory easily with set amounts on your chosen card. Please try it if you normally give via cash.
