## WINTER PRAYER MEETING

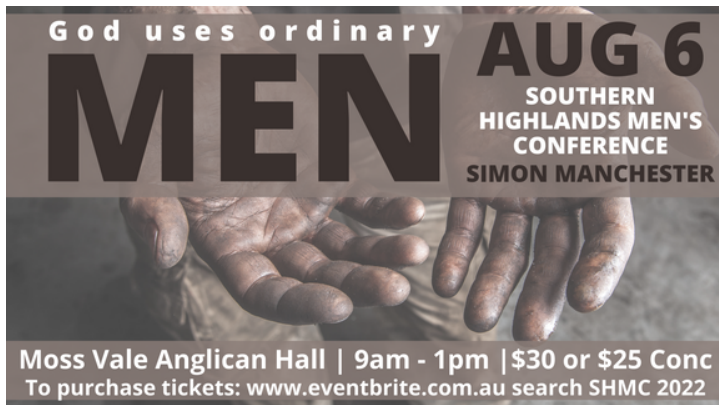

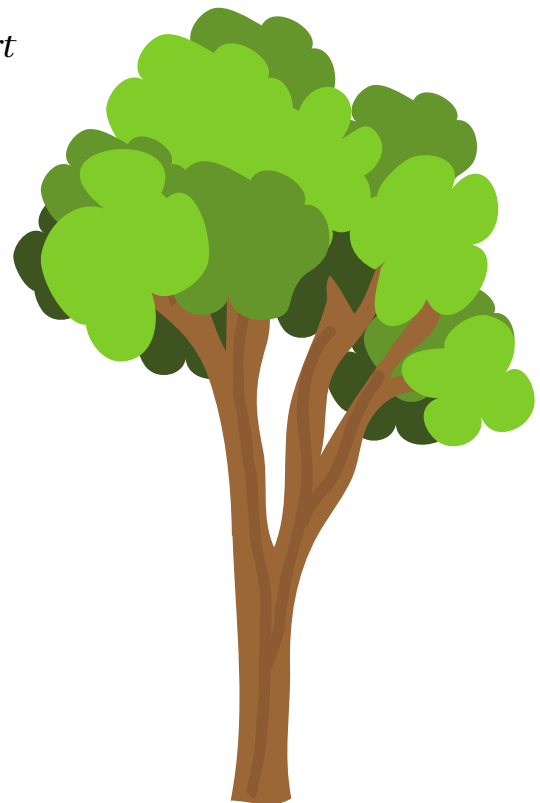
